Details / documents required for registration

- Birth certificates
- If previously divorced, legal documentation of the divorce (degree absolute)
- If either party is a widow/widower, death certificate of former spouse(s)
- If either party is less than 18 years of age, evidence of parental concern in the form of a sworn statement
- Certificates concerning any names changed by deed poll
- Passports of bride and groom
- An affidavit signed by a solicitor stating that neither the bride nor groom has been previously married and that there is no legal objection to the marriage

The following information about the bride and groom must be contained in the affidavit

- Full names and addresses of the bride and groom and the parents of both parties
- Professions of the bride, groom and the fathers of both parties

All of the above documents must be originals and in English. If in a language other than English, an official translation in English must be supplied

The couple should be in the hotel 4 days prior to the date of wedding ceremony

Photocopies of the above documents must reach us at least 3 weeks prior to the wedding and the couple should bring the originals with them
