The Setting

On the shores of Kandalama Lake in the heart of Sri Lanka's Cultural Triangle. Amaya Lake, located in Dambulla, 160 kilometres from Colombo, is a 40-acre sanctuary that surrounds guests with nature. An ideal base for exploring the ancient monuments of the Cultural Triangle.

Ninety-two Sri Lankan villas scattered amongst the trees of the forested grounds. Each features:

Club Lodges
